

SPAGHETTI



Description

Macsim Plastic Plugging (or Spaghetti as it is more commonly known as) is used in conjunction with standard bullet head nails to secure battens and skirting to brick, concrete and other solid masonry materials. Plastic Spaghetti is safe, secure and most effective method of fastening and as you cut it to length there is no wastage of material.

Features

- Available in different lengths
- Cut to required size so there is no wastage of material

Typical Applications

- Skirtings
- Battens
- Boxing for pre-cast panel forming

Installation Procedure

1. With the batten/skirting in place, drill through it and into the base material to the required depth. (usually 30mm to 35mm into base material is sufficient).
2. Insert Spaghetti into the hole and push down until it "bottoms" in the base material.
3. Cut the Spaghetti off flush with the surface.
4. Insert correct length nail into the mouth of the Spaghetti and drive "home" with a hammer.
